Background and Purpose: This RFP was developed by the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) in collaboration with Public Health Solutions as part of DOHMH's commitment to promoting health equity and sexual and reproductive justice (SRJ) and undoing injustice through community-based activities. The DOHMH's mission for this initiative includes prioritizing individual choice and body autonomy within the contexts of historical events, lived experiences, sexualities, and social conditions.

Contractors awarded from this RFP, listed above, are tasked with activities including:

- Develop and implement community-led, neighborhood-based programming and action to increase community awareness of SRJ and its connection to a range of health and social issues
- Promote sexual and reproductive justice through community-based activities
- Participate in Community Engagement Group to collectively promote SRJ in NYC
- Conduct community needs assessment on access to health education and services
- Develop and implement a service delivery plan for fostering SRJ in targeted communities
- Develop and implement an evaluation plan to assess the effectiveness of community-based activities in promoting SRJ goals and values
